GOLF TERRACE STREET RECONSTRUCTION

Dear Residents:

General Contractor Schedule

Stage 1:

Crews will continue to work on other minor restoration items in this area of the project.

Important: Late next week crews are planning to pave the final layer of blacktop on your streets. They will hand deliver a notice containing information on this process prior to the work taking place.

Stage 2 and 3:

Utility crews should have all the upgrades to the watermain, sanitary sewer, and storm sewer utilities completed by the end of the week.

Crews have now started re-grading the roadway on Sherwood Avenue and Dalrymple Road and will continue digging out the existing road bed and replacing it with suitable gravel base materials. Once they have passed your driveway, they will backfill with gravel and build a ramp for access to your driveway. This will be a moving process. Upon completion of grading Sherwood Avenue, crews will move to Lakeview Drive, St. Andrews Avenue, and Lexington Street.

The streets will be accessible during the grading work. You may encounter certain periods when access may be limited. Crews may ask you to move your vehicle out for the day and park it offsite prior to the work taking place. Feel free to ask a crew member for help if you need special assistance or direction.

It will take approximately one week to finish the grading portion of the entire project. Once this portion of the project is complete, concrete crews will move on site. At this time, the anticipated start day for working on the curb and gutter is Wednesday, and completion by the end of the week.

Crews will hand deliver a notice to your home that will contain instructions on the concrete process, on street parking, and warranty while the concrete work cures. Please watch your front door for this notice.

Trash/Recycling Service Pickup:

Because of the construction, the time of day your provider picks up your garbage and recycling has been changed to **Monday, 6:00 a.m., until further notice**. Please have your garbage and recycling at the curb no later than **5:30 a.m.** on the day of pickup.

Safety:

Please remind your children to stay away from construction sites, construction machinery, and stockpiled materials. These sites, machines, and materials can be dangerous. Job site safety is our number one concern for everyone.

Who to Contact in an Emergency:

During a life or property-threatening emergency, call 911. If construction equipment or materials need to be moved as part of dealing with the emergency, 911 has a list of the contractor's emergency contacts.

If it is not an emergency, you can also get a hold of the **police on their non-emergency phone number at 952-826-1600**. They have a list of contractors and contacts if the need for their services arises after hours.
