GOLF TERRACE STREET RECONSTRUCTION

Dear Residents:

Please note the following update has been broken into two parts:

Private Utility Reconstruction Schedule

CenterPoint Energy and Michels will continue working on gas main and service work upgrades in all stages of the neighborhood. They will be in contact with you as needed to get this upgrade completed. Stage 2 & 3 will also see crews working to install new gas service lines as the weeks move forward.

General Contractor Schedule

At this time, Palda and Sons anticipates beginning the reconstruction project in Stage 1 on July 25. Crews will mobilize on site and begin by removing the paved roadway surface. Crews will then follow up by beginning work on the watermain upgrades in the neighborhood.

Crews from Palda and Sons will soon begin installing a temporary water main pipe to your home. This pipe will be placed across your front lawn and be connected to your house at your hose bib. Crews may need to enter your home to operate your water shut off valve in your basement. This is done to isolate the connections until the new main has been installed and tested. Palda and Sons will coordinate this work with you using a door tag, or by knocking to see if you are home. This will be done on a case by case basis.

Please be careful when cutting your grass near the temporary water service pipe as it can be damaged by your lawn mower. If applicable, please pass this warning along to your lawn service.

While being provided water from the temporary water main, you may notice your tap water is warmer than usual. This is normal. It is caused by the fact that the water main is above ground and subject to ambient air temperatures.

As you may be aware, some of the subcontractors have already been working in the neighborhood performing minor work. This will help facilitate and speed up the project as it progresses through the summer.

We are working on putting together a construction update letter that will give you more specific information on the project and process. We hope to have this letter out to you early next week.

Safety

Please remind your children to stay away from construction sites, construction machinery, and stockpiled materials. These sites, machines, and materials can be dangerous. Job site safety is our number one concern for everyone.

Who to Contact in an Emergency

During a life or property-threatening emergency, call 911. If construction equipment or materials need to be moved as part of dealing with the emergency, 911 has a list of the contractor's emergency contacts.

If it is not an emergency, you can also get a hold of the Edina Police Dept. on their non-emergency phone number at 952-826-1600. They have a list of contractors and contacts if the need for their services arises after hours.
