GOLF TERRACE STREET RECONSTRUCTION

Dear Residents:

General Contractor Schedule

Stage 1:

Crews will continue working on some small clean up issues in your area of the neighborhood.

Stage 2 and 3:

Crews have completed paving the first layer of blacktop on your street. They have now begun the restoration phase.

Crews will continue to rough grade and shape lawn areas behind the new curb and gutter with black dirt.

Contractors are currently working to repair irrigation and pet fence systems. If they haven't already, crews will soon be contacting you about irrigation and pet fence system repairs. They will repair the lines as needed, and adjust them accordingly.

If you haven't had your system winterized, please now schedule for this work to be done by your company.

If you have already had it winterized, crews will have to do the necessary adjustments next spring.

Please keep in mind the contractor only repairs the damage to the systems caused by the construction project. You will need to have your irrigation system winterized, if you haven't already, at your own expense.

Sod restoration is scheduled to begin early next week. Please watch your front doors when sod crews arrive for a notice. This notice will contain special information in regards to late season sod placement and warranty.

Once the contractor completes the restoration phase of the project, they will place the final layer of blacktop. At this time, crews are scheduled to pave this final layer early the week of November 7th, 2011.

Trash/Recycling Service Pickup:

Because of the construction, the time of day your provider picks up your garbage and recycling has been changed to **Monday, 6:00 a.m., until further notice**. Please have your garbage and recycling at the curb no later than **5:30 a.m.** on the day of pickup.

Safety:

Please remind your children to stay away from construction sites, construction machinery, and stockpiled materials. These sites, machines, and materials can be dangerous. Job site safety is our number one concern for everyone.

Who to Contact in an Emergency:

During a life or property-threatening emergency, call 911. If construction equipment or materials need to be moved as part of dealing with the emergency, 911 has a list of the contractor's emergency contacts.

If it is not an emergency, you can also get a hold of the **police on their non-emergency phone number at 952-826-1600**. They have a list of contractors and contacts if the need for their services arises after hours.
