Your contractor **must** complete their work within the period given in the table below.

| Work Item               | Date                    |
|-------------------------|-------------------------|
| Start System(s) Repair  | Monday, August 10, 2009 |
| Finish System(s) Repair | Sunday, August 16, 2009 |

Your contractor must **not** slow down Midwest's progress.

Your contractor **must** submit their invoice for the work they do at your home to the City of Edina, Engineering Department. City staff will review the invoice to verify their work was for repairs associated with Midwest's activities. If the outcome of their review is satisfactory, the City will pay your contractor directly.
