## **Carsons Hill Neighborhood Reconstruction**

Dear Resident:

Please note that this update is divided into two sections. The first section, Phase Updates, contains specific information pertaining to particular residents while the second section, Overall Updates, contains important information pertaining to all residents.

### **Private Utility Reconstruction Schedule**

CenterPoint Energy and Michels will continue working on gas service work upgrades in all Phases of the neighborhood. They will be in contact with you as needed to get this upgrade completed.

### **PHASE UPDATES**

#### **Phase A** - (Leslee Lane, Jeffrey Lane and Kaymar Drive)

Due to the rain yesterday and today Midwest Asphalt is going to work tomorrow and reclaim the existing street making it a gravel road on Kaymar Drive. Next week Midwest will start removing the old roadbed. Please be aware of the truck traffic involved with the grading process. Crews will notify you prior to working in front of your driveway because you may not be able to access your driveway during the excavation. If need be, they will arrange a place for you to park. By the end of the day you will have access to your driveway. Feel free to talk with the crew onsite if you have questions or concerns about access.

#### **Phase B** - (Highwood Drive, Highwood Drive West (south of Idylwood Drive), Heather Lane and Saxony Road)

Northdale has just about finished all the utilities in the street. They still have a few fire hydrants on Heather Lane and some storm sewer improvements to do in the neighborhood. Northdale will not be back on site until Thursday of next week and they will be re-notifying you of any inconveniences a day prior.

Midwest Asphalt will also be reclaiming on Highwood Drive just north of Vernon to the first intersection this Saturday.

### **Safety**

Please remind your children to stay away from construction sites, construction machinery, and stockpiled materials. These sites, machines, and materials can be dangerous. Job site safety is our number one concern.

### **Who to Contact in an Emergency**

During a life or property-threatening emergency, call 911. If construction equipment or materials need to be moved as part of dealing with the emergency, 911 has a list of the contractor's emergency contacts.
