Dear Resident:

All concrete work is close to completion. By end of the day crews are allowing access back into all driveways as the concrete is now cured enough to drive over.

If you have a blacktop driveway it will be backfilled with gravel until the paving crew is on site. This should happen sometime next week. If you have been thinking about replacing your entire driveway and would like a quote from Northwest Asphalt here is their contact information.

Next week, crews will start grading the gravel roadway and getting ready for the first layer of Asphalt which should be placed in two weeks. Once this is paved, they will begin the restoration process.

Northwest Asphalt will have someone available to water the road surface over the weekend as needed to help keep the dust down.
