Killarney Shores Neighborhood Reconstruction

Dear Resident:

Crews have now completed paving the first layer of blacktop on your street.

The next week crews will be on site to begin working on the restoration phase of the project. They will be backfilling curbing, preparing areas for new sod, restoring blacktop and paver driveways, repairing irrigation systems, site cleanup, etc.

Crews will also be working to expose and bring the old manhole castings to grade in the street to final grade. They will be digging up the areas marked to expose the manholes. Please expect minor traffic delays in areas where all crews are working.

In about 2 weeks, crews will be lining the sanitary sewer in the neighborhood.

Once all work has been completed in the restoration phase, the contractor will place the final layer of blacktop on your street. At this time, this work is anticipated the week of August 8th, 2011.

Safety

Please remind your children to stay away from construction sites, construction machinery, and stockpiled materials. These sites, machines, and materials can be dangerous. Job site safety is our number one concern.
