Dear Resident:

Crews will soon begin working on the grading of the roadway. They will be grinding up the rest of the existing paved roadway surfaces on the project. Crews will then remove curb and gutter pieces as marked in the field, and spend the rest of the week digging out approximately one foot of the existing road bed, and replacing it with suitable gravel material. Please be aware of the truck traffic involved with the grading process. Crews will notify you prior to working in front of your driveway because you may not be able to access your driveway during the excavation. If need be, they will arrange a place for you to park. By the end of the day you will have access to your driveway. Feel free to talk with the crew onsite if you have questions or concerns about access. It will take approximately 2 weeks to complete the grading portion of the project.

As the grading nears completion, concrete crews will move on site. They will begin installing curb and gutter, and restoring concrete driveways. You will be notified by an orange flyer in your front door. This flyer will have instructions on where to park your car, and contain information on the 7-day curing period for the new concrete. Concrete needs time to cure before it can handle the weight of a vehicle. During this time, you will need to park on the street in front of your home. Please watch your front door for this notice. Crews will place this a day in advance to keep you informed of where/when to move your car out and where to park.

Safety:

As the school year comes to an end, please remind your children to stay away from construction sites, construction machinery, and stockpiled materials. These sites, machines, and materials can be dangerous. Job site safety is our number one concern.

Who to Contact in an Emergency:

During a life or property-threatening emergency, call 911. If construction equipment or materials need to be moved as part of dealing with the emergency, 911 has a list of the contractor's emergency contacts.
