Oscar Roberts Neighborhood Reconstruction

Dear Resident,

Crews will continue working on installing the new curb and gutter on the project. They will also continue working on replacing the concrete driveways that were removed to facilitate construction work.

If there was new concrete curb and gutter recently placed by your home, you should have received a flyer with instructions regarding where to park your car, and on the 7-day curing period for the new concrete. During the 7-day curing period, you will need to park on the street in front of your home. We have asked the Edina Police Dept. to work with us to allow you to park on the street during the curing process.

Later next week, once the concrete has gained enough strength to support a vehicles weight, grading crews will begin to shape the roadways for paving. They will coordinate with you the access back into your driveways.

Crews plan on paving your street in about a week. The roadway will be open to traffic while they pave, and it is safe to drive on it. Crews will direct you onsite where to drive, etc. as the paving process proceeds. While they are paving there will be no parking allowed on your street. This will help to facilitate the trucking and paving process and speed up the operation.

Safety

Please remind your children to stay away from construction sites, construction machinery, and stockpiled materials. These sites, machines, and materials can be dangerous. Job site safety is our number one concern.

Who to Contact in an Emergency

During a life or property-threatening emergency, call 911. If construction equipment or materials need to be moved as part of dealing with the emergency, 911 have a list of the contractor's emergency contacts. If it is not an emergency, you can also get a hold of the Edina Police Dept. on their non-emergency phone number at 952-826-1600.
