## **McCauley Heights Neighborhood Reconstruction**

Dear Resident:

Concrete crews have moved on site and began pouring concrete curb and gutter on McCauley Circle and Post Lane. Today they will be pour concrete aprons on those streets. On Tuesday of next week they will start concrete curb and gutter on McCauley Terrace following by concrete aprons the next day. You will be notified by a flyer in your front door. This flyer will have instructions on where to park your car, and contain information on the 7-day curing period for the new concrete. During this time, you will need to park on the street in front of your home while the new concrete hardens for 7 days. Please watch your front door for this notice.

If you have a blacktop driveway it will be backfilled with gravel until the paving crew is on site. This should happen sometime next week. If you have been thinking about replacing your entire driveway and would like a quote from Northwest Asphalt here is their contact information.

Northwest Asphalt will have someone available to water the road surface over the weekend as needed to help keep the dust down.

Once the black dirt is backfilled behind the new curb, we will begin the process of repairing damaged irrigation systems and pet fences. This will be completed by the Contractor on site.
