## **McCauley Heights Neighborhood Reconstruction**

Dear Resident:

Northwest Asphalt will be in your neighborhood starting Monday. They will start over on McCauley Terrace with utility upgrades then move over to McCauley Circle and Post Lane starting Tuesday.

During the utility upgrades in the neighborhood crews will be replacing the fire hydrants. The water to your homes will need to be shut off to do this work. If the shut off affects you, the contractor will notify you a day in advance by hanging a notice on your front door that will tell you the shut off time and duration of the shutdown. The shut offs typically are done after 8:00 am, and crews work to get the water system back on as fast as possible.

Water main reconstruction and hydrant replacements though the neighborhood may cause rust colored water to come out of your faucets, this is normal. You can simply flush all the reddish color out your laundry faucet, since these generally do not have a lot of screens to trap the material.

### **Safety**

Please remind your children to stay away from construction sites, construction machinery, and stockpiled materials. These sites, machines, and materials can be dangerous. Job site safety is our number one concern.

### **Who to Contact in an Emergency**

During a life or property-threatening emergency, call 911. If construction equipment or materials need to be moved as part of dealing with the emergency, 911 has a list of the contractor's emergency contacts. If it is not an emergency, you can also get a hold of the Edina Police Dept. on their non-emergency phone number at 952-826-1600.
