## **Killarney Shores Neighborhood Reconstruction**

Dear Resident:

The rain and wet conditions this week have slowed the crews but they plan on finishing all the concrete work by early next week.

The sump drain main line on Shaefer Road has been completed and the Contractor has started installation on Killarney Lane.

Once the concrete curb and sump drain main is completed the Contractor will begin backfilling the boulevards with soil. This is the time when they will repair damaged irrigation systems and pet fences.

Please remind your children to stay away from construction sites, construction machinery, and stockpiled materials. These sites, machines, and materials can be dangerous. Job site safety is our number one concern.
