Killarney Shores Neighborhood Reconstruction

Dear Resident:

The Edina City Council has awarded the roadway and utility construction project in your neighborhood to Northwest Asphalt, Inc. As part of the construction process, private utility companies have started their work in your neighborhood. The major upgrades of private utilities will be replacing a few gas service lines and cable service lines to your home. CenterPoint Energy and Comcast Cable have hired their own contractors to upgrade these utilities. Keep in mind that these are a separate private utility upgrade that is not directly associated with your neighborhood project. They will have a project superintendent onsite to assist you with getting your service lines upgraded.

As the private utility upgrades near their completion, we will begin with the neighborhood reconstruction project. At this time, crews plan on starting the work in your neighborhood the week of **May 23, 2011**. We'll be able to provide a more detailed construction schedule with the next update letter. Our initial work will involve the replacement of fire hydrants, sanitary sewer repair work, and storm sewer upgrades. Hydrant replacements will require temporary shut downs to water services in the neighborhood for part of the day. You will be notified of these shut downs at least a day in advance by the contractor.

**Communication**

To better communicate the overall happenings of the project, the City has introduced the City Extra e-mail notification service. This service is free and allows individuals to sign up to receive e-mail messages from the City on a variety of topics. We will update the City Extra e-mail notification system on a weekly basis for this project. These updates will be brief but will cover the weekly street reconstruction highlights. All residents, including those signed up for the e-mail notification system, will continue to receive paper copies of the construction update letters by regular mail on a monthly basis.
