McCauley Heights Neighborhood Reconstruction

Dear Resident:

Due to the past weeks rain and wet conditions, crews have been unable to work on the project.

Monday, crews will start working on the grading of the roadway.

It will be a moving process; crews will be digging out approximately one foot of the existing road bed, and replacing it with gravel material. Once they have passed your driveway, crews will backfill with gravel and the contractor will build a ramp to access your driveway.

Please do not park any vehicles on the roadway. The streets will be accessible during the grading work, however the contractor will need to use the full street for the reconstruction process. You may encounter certain periods when access to your driveway may be limited. Feel free to ask for help from the crew onsite if you need special assistance.

It will take approximately 1 week to complete the grading portion of the project.

Safety

Please remind your children to stay away from construction sites, construction machinery, and stockpiled materials. These sites, machines, and materials can be dangerous. Job site safety is our number one concern.

Who to Contact in an Emergency

During a life or property-threatening emergency, call 911. If construction equipment or materials need to be moved as part of dealing with the emergency, 911 has a list of the contractor's emergency contacts.
