**Overall Updates**

**Striping**

The contractor will be striping the roadway next week. Although it doesn't take long to apply the striping, it does take time for the striping to be dry enough for vehicular traffic. The contractor will place cones near the new striping, please be cautious not to drive over the fresh paint.

**Signs**

New street signs, stop signs and other signage is anticipated to be installed next week.

**Restoration**

Please do not rake or blow your leaves on the newly restored areas in order to keep the hydromulch in place. If you use a lawn service company, please inform them of this. The contractor is still responsible for maintenance of the restored area including watering. We have seen that in general, grass is growing more rapidly in yards that are being watered by the homeowner, so we are encouraging you to continue this.

**On-street Parking**

On-street parking will still not be allowed during the day while the contractor is working. Please inform guests, customers, and private contractors of this.

**Safety**

Please watch your speed as there will still be equipment moving around and construction workers doing their job to ensure a quality product and it is important that they feel safe. And as always, please remind your children to stay away from construction sites. Job site safety is our number one concern.
